

# PROHIBITED ITEMS




**Liquids, aerosols and gels** in quantities greater than 100ml  
**Drinks**, including **alcohol, beer, soft drinks, water**  
**Flasks, thermos**  
**Glass bottles** (excluding medication contained in glass bottles up to 100ml)



**Working tools**



**Noisemakers** such as **hunting horns, air horns, klaxons, megaphones, vuvuzelas and whistles**



**Motorcycle helmets**



**Baby carriage**



**More than one soft-sided bag of 25 litre capacity** (you must be able to fit your bag under your seat)



**Walkie-talkies, phone jammers and radio scanners**

**Personal/private wireless access points and 3G hubs** (smart devices such as Android phones, iPhone and tablets are permitted inside venues, but must not be used as wireless access points to connect multiple devices)

**Laser pointers and strobe lights**



**Items too large to be electronically screened**



**Bicycles, folding bikes, roller-skates and skateboards**



**Pets or animals** (excluding service animals)



**All types of knives and bladed items**, including pocket knives and knives carried as part of cultural dress

**Offensive weapons or implements** such as bayonets, flick knives, extendable batons, sharpened combs, modified belt buckles and loose blades modified into weapons

**Items that resemble prohibited items** such as replica guns or hoax explosive devices

**Personal protection sprays** such as CS or pepper sprays

**Firearms and ammunition** (including replicas, component parts or any device suspected to be a firearm)




**Explosives, flares and smoke canisters**


**Any kind of flammable/explosive substances**, liquids or gases or other flammable substances including but not limited to fireworks



**Hazardous and toxic materials**



**Controlled drugs**, including substances which look like controlled drugs



**Tents, placards, spray paint** or any other item which could be used to demonstrate within the venue or sabotage property



**Poles** (i.e. flag poles) of hard material and/or longer than 1 meter



**Balls, rackets, frisbees** or similar objects or projectiles



**All other objects and substances** that might endanger security, public health, public order and/or reputation of FIBA, Local Organising Committee and venue



**Video cameras**, regardless of size, model, range and selfie sticks

**Any telephoto lens above 150mm aperture including tripods and monopods.**

You cannot use photographic or broadcast equipment for commercial purposes unless you hold media accreditation



**Paper rolls** (including toilet paper, cash register rolls, confetti)



**Any flags except the official country flags of the teams participating in a FIBA competition**



**"Excessive amount of food"** - people should be allowed to bring a sandwich or some snacks



**Drones and remotes**

**The following items are prohibited (not allowed) in the venues of a FIBA competition. Persons carrying any of the items above will not be allowed into the venues and may be transferred to the local law enforcement representatives.**
