



# FIBA 3x3 Individual World Ranking Quick Guide


Edition 2015

## How is the individual ranking worked out?

Individual rankings will be calculated Monday to Thursday, at 1200 hours UTC, except between 24 December and 06 January (both inclusive) based on ranking points collected at all FIBA-endorsed events and pick-up games; without prejudice of precedent ranking will be calculated on 1 November irrespectively of date of the week.

1. **The best 3 FIBA 3x3 World Tour results and the best 6 FIBA-endorsed events (except 3 best World Tour) results** played over the last year. The number of points earned at a tournament will depend on the event level and:
  - i. number of wins & losses in the pool or league games
  - ii. the final standings
  - iii. individual performance based on scored points (if applicable).
2. **The best 200 pick-up results** over the last year with a limit of 10 results per day.

### a) Event level

For avoidance of doubt, events classifying to a Quest stop are considered as a Satellite stop and events classifying to a Zone Champs are considered one level below.

Wheelchair is always considered white. U15 cannot play in black events.

## b) Points collected at events

There is only one table of points for all FIBA-endorsed events. Points will depend on the level of the event (crescendo from white to black) and:

1. Final standing
2. Pool results: The best 3 results during the round robin phase of a pool
3. Individual scoring: each players' best five scoring performances

Incomplete registration data****	1 downgrade

Gradings can be cumulated, minimum color is white. U13 is always white irrespectively of gradings.

In any FIBA-endorsed competition, in the categories with full scouting, points can be collected for individual performance based on the following formula:

Points collected

= number of points scored (in the best five individual performances) / 20 \* factor

### c) Points collected at pick-up games

	Win	Loss

With a limit of 10 pick-ups per day

### d) Points lost due to sanctions

Sanctions to player by FIBA can include the partial or complete loss of ranking points. Examples:

- Players not playing at FIBA 3x3 Official Competitions, in spite of being registered or qualified, will automatically lose all ranking points collected at FIBA 3x3 Official Competitions, except in case of proven injury or justified force majeure.
- Players forfeiting two games will not earn any ranking points in said competition except in case of justified force majeure.
