AWARD

Upon providing all parties with an opportunity to be heard, having examined her jurisdiction and considered the factual and legal arguments as well as the requests for relief submitted in this case, the Arbitrator decides as follows:

- 1. Galatasaray Spor Kulübü Derneği shall pay Mr. Jordan Taylor unpaid salaries of USD 45,000.00 net, plus interest on such amount at 5% per annum until payment**
 - from 1 May 2018 on the amount of USD 22,500.00; and
 - from 31 May 2018 on the amount of USD 22,500.00.
- 2. Galatasaray Spor Kulübü Derneği shall pay Pensack Sports unpaid agency fees of USD 6,750.00 net, plus interest on such amount at 5% per annum from 16 February 2018 until payment.**
- 3. The costs of this arbitration until the present Award, which were determined by the President of the BAT to be in the amount of EUR 2,950.00, shall be borne by Galatasaray Spor Kulübü Derneği alone. Accordingly, Galatasaray Spor Kulübü Derneği shall pay jointly to Mr. Jordan Taylor and Pensack Sports EUR 2,950.00. The balance of the Advance on Costs, in the amount of EUR 3,030.60 will be reimbursed jointly to Mr. Jordan Taylor and Pensack Sports by the BAT.**
- 4. Galatasaray Spor Kulübü Derneği shall pay jointly to Mr. Jordan Taylor and Pensack Sports EUR 4,080.00 as a contribution to their legal fees and expenses.**
- 5. Any arbitration costs associated with a Request for Reasons (see attached Notice) shall be advanced and borne by the requesting party.**
- 6. Any other or further-reaching requests for relief are dismissed.**

Notice about Request for Reasons

- b) pays the respective advance on costs as determined and within the time limit set by the BAT Secretariat.”*

The Parties are herewith informed that the amount to be paid as an advance on costs for a reasoned award in this case has been set by the BAT Secretariat to **EUR 5,000.00**. The time limit for payment thereof will be set by the BAT Secretariat upon receipt of the Request for Reasons, if any.
