## **AWARD**

Upon providing both parties with an opportunity to be heard, having ascertained his jurisdiction and considered the factual and legal arguments as well as the requests for relief submitted in this case, the Arbitrator decides as follows:

- 1. Pinar Karsiyaka shall pay Mr. Josh Boone USD 15,000.00 for breach of the Termination Agreement.**
- 2. Pinar Karsiyaka shall pay Mr. Josh Boone USD 9,100.00 in respect of late payment fees.**
- 3. Pinar Karsiyaka shall pay interest on the sum of USD 15,000.00, at a rate of 5% per annum, from 2 June 2017 until payment.**
- 4. The costs of this arbitration until the present Award, which were determined by the President of the BAT to be in the amount of EUR 4,375.00, shall be borne in the following shares: (a) 80% by Pinar Karsiyaka; and (b) 20% by Mr. Josh Boone. Accordingly, Pinar Karsiyaka shall pay EUR 3,500.00 to Mr. Josh Boone. The balance of the Advance on Costs, in the amount of EUR 1,125.00, will be reimbursed to Mr. Josh Boone by the BAT.**
- 5. Pinar Karsiyaka shall make a contribution towards Mr. Josh Boone's legal fees and expenses in the amount of EUR 4,000.**
- 6. Any arbitration costs associated with a Request for Reasons (see attached Notice) shall be advanced and borne by the requesting party.**

**7. Any other or further-reaching requests for relief are dismissed.**

### **Notice about Request for Reasons**

in accordance with Articles 16.2 of the BAT Rules:

*“By agreeing to submit their dispute to arbitration under these Rules, the Parties agree that, where the value of the dispute does not exceed EUR 100,000, the Arbitrator shall issue an award without reasons, provided, however, that the Arbitrator shall deliver reasons if a party*

- a) files a request to that effect at any stage from when the Request for Arbitration is filed until no later than ten (10) days after the notification of the award without reasons; and*
- b) pays the respective advance on costs as determined and within the time limit set by the BAT Secretariat.”*

The Parties are herewith informed that the amount to be paid as an advance on costs for a reasoned award in this case has been set by the BAT Secretariat to **EUR 5,000.00**. The time limit for payment thereof will be set by the BAT Secretariat upon receipt of the Request for Reasons, if any.
