EUROPEAN WOMEN'S BASKETBALL SUMMIT (EWBS)

FIBA Europe Program project proposal:

- Mono-beneficiary: **FIBA Europe** will apply and manage the project.
- Aim: to give the opportunity to female coaches & referees from Europe to improve their competences (**WB Summit**) and acquire new skills through **learning mobility** by participating in the “European Women’s Basketball Summit”. In addition, a selected group of participants will be mentored by FIBA Europe instructors for a period of 12 months by spending a period of time job-shadowing during visits to the mentors.
- Target: **Female basketball coaches and referees**
- Activities: exchanges of coaches and referees, placements, set periods of training/study and job-shadowing
- Cooperation:
 - Beneficiary **FIBA Europe** (GER)
 - LOT1: Western Balkans -> **KSS** (SRB)
 - 4 Partners: **KZS** (SLO), **FEB** (ESP), **Basketball Finland** (FIN), **FFBB** (FRA)
 - Other participants from around Europe (same conditions as in the past editions)
- Budget: **€200.000**. EU grant + co-financing rate of 20% by FIBA Europe.
- Duration: **24 months**.

LOT – WESTERN BALKANS

Serbian Basketball is one of the best and most recognized basketball schools in the world (for men and women), in both areas: coaching and officiating.

- ❑ To lead the coaching program, FIBA Europe will select the renowned Serbian Basketball coach **Marina Maljkovic**, who led Serbia to the European Champion title and bronze medals at the Olympic Games in Rio
- ❑ The referee's program will be led by the best Serbian female referee **Jasmina Juras**. She is one of only two female FIBA Referees with a black license to officiate all FIBA basketball competitions, men and women, and 3x3 international events.

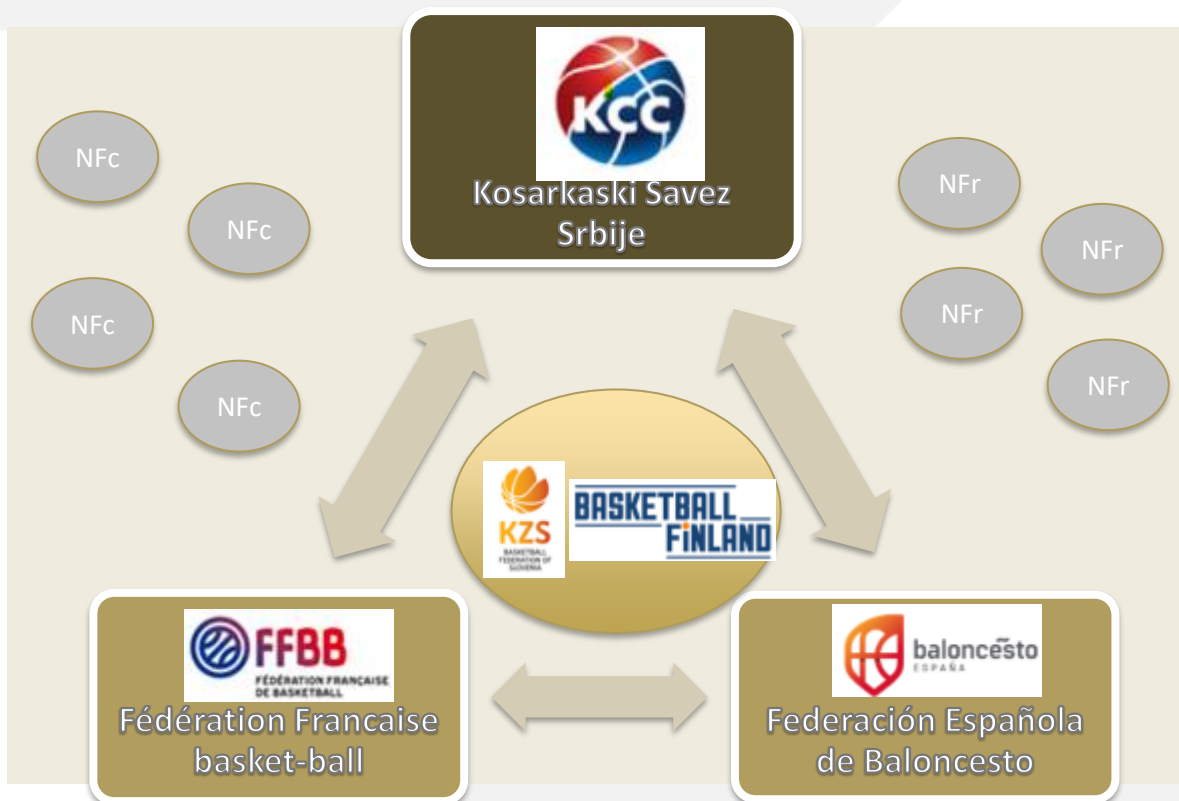
Both will be the experts in charge of creating, leading, and delivering the exchange & mobility training program specifically aimed at young and talented female coaches and referees from all over Europe.

FIBA Europe will invite all of their national federations to contribute in the selection process of suitable candidates by submitting one candidature of a female coach, and one of a female referee to take part at the summit in Slovenia:

- ❑ Countries from the Western Balkans area with low development, will have a preference for the mentoring program, if fulfill the requirements.

For additional strengthening of the program, FIBA Europe will appoint instructors from other top European countries to support the exchange and sharing of knowledge (ESP, FRA FIN, SLO).
