

2 VISA EXEMPTION (SHORT-TERM STAY) 4 PERIOD OF STAY

The period of stay granted at the time of the landing permission will be "15 days" for Indonesia, and Thailand, "14 days" for Brunei, "30 days" for United Arab Emirates and "90 days" for other countries and regions.

(Note 1)

For nationals of Indonesia (since December 1, 2014), visas are not required only for those who have registered ICAO-compliant ePassport to diplomatic missions of Japan in Indonesia (the embassy, consulates-general, or the consulate). Validity of the registration is three years period or until the passport expires, whichever comes first.

• (Note 2)

For nationals of Malaysia (since July 1, 2013), visas are not required only for holders of ePassport in compliance with ICAO standards. Those who do not hold such ePassport are advised to obtain a visa in advance, otherwise will be strictly examined and may be refused entry to Japan.

• (Note 3)

For nationals of United Arab Emirates (since November 1, 2022), Thailand (since July 1, 2013) and Serbia (since May 1, 2011), visas are not required only for holders of ePassport in compliance with ICAO standards. Those who do not hold such ePassport are requested to obtain a visa in advance, otherwise will be refused to enter Japan.





• (Note 4)

For citizens of Hong Kong, visas are not required only for holders of Special Administrative Region (SAR) passport issued by the Hong Kong SAR of the People's Republic of China or British National Overseas (BNO) passports who have the right of residence in Hong Kong.

• (Note 5)

For citizens of Macao, visas are not required only for holders of SAR passport issued by the Macao SAR of the People's Republic of China.

• (Note 6)

Visa exemption arrangements for Taiwan is limited to passport holders with a personal ID number.

• (Note 7)

For nationals of Barbados (since April 1, 2010), Turkey (since April 1, 2011) and Lesotho (since April 1, 2010), visas are not required only for holders of Machine-Readable Passport (MRP) in compliance with ICAO standards. Those who do not hold an MRP are advised to obtain a visa in advance, otherwise will be strictly examined and may be refused entry to Japan.

• (Note 8)

For nationals of those countries with visa exemptions permitting stays of up to 6 months under the bilateral visa exemption arrangements, those who wish to stay in Japan for more than 90 days are required to apply for an extension of the period of stay to the Ministry of Justice (Regional Immigration Bureau) before the period of permitted stay is to expire.


3 VISA PROCEDURES

For the countries not listed on the Visa Exemption list, Short-Term Stay Visa will be required when entering Japan for the FBWC 2023.



No pre-departure testing required.

Information of the 1st and 2nd vaccination (Vaccine type, Date etc) will also be required




Requirements

for a valid vaccination certificate (3 doses)
All entrants who obtain valid vaccination certificates will not be required to obtain certificate of testing for COVID-19.

Vaccination certificates are valid only if they meet the following requirements 1-3.

The certificate must be issued by a government or public institution.



- "Vaccination Certificate of COVID-19" issued by the Japanese government or a local government
- "Certificate of Vaccination for COVID-19" issued by a local government
- "Record of Vaccination for COVID-19" issued by a medical institution
- Another certificate deemed equivalent to documents listed above

The following items must be shown in Japanese or English:

Name Date of birth Vaccine name / Manufacturer Date of vaccination The number of doses administered

- * If date of birth is not included in the certificate, it may still be considered valid if it contains your passport number or other information that can be used to verify that the vaccination certificate is yours.
- * If the vaccination certificate is in a language other than Japanese or English, it may be considered valid if it is accompanied by a Japanese or English translation and the content can be confirmed.

The certificate must clearly show that you have received 3 doses of any of the following vaccines:

Requirements for Certificate of Testing for Entering Japan

XOnly test certificates which show the results of the test using valid samples and testing methods below are valid.

- Nasopharyngeal/Nasopharynx/NP (Swab/smear)
- Rhinopharyngeal/Rhinopharynx (Swab/smear)
- Nasal Swab

Nasal Swab is valid when the test method is NAAT.



For those who are entering Japan from China starting April 5th, 2023.

After 00:00 JST on April 5th*, 2023, temporary measures will apply to all those who are entering Japan via a direct flight from China (excluding Hong Kong and Macau).

* Temporary measures will apply to those who board an aircraft with an estimated time of arrival after 00:00 JST on April 5th, 2023.

- After 00:00 JST on April 5th, 2023, all those who are entering Japan via a direct flight from China (excluding Hong Kong and Macau) are required to obtain either a valid vaccination certificate or a certificate of Pre-departure Test as per the previous measures.
- Passengers who have not obtained a valid vaccination certificate or a certificate of Predeparture Test in the country of departure before boarding, will be denied boarding the aircraft
- From March 1st, 2023, a sampling test is conducted for all those who are entering Japan via a direct flight from China (excluding Hong Kong and Macau). Only collecting test samples is done in the airport. For details, please refer to the attached sheet "Regarding the implementation of COVID-19 test for passengers of the flights for which the test is required.".
- Please pre-register the information required for quarantine procedures via "Visit Japan Web".
