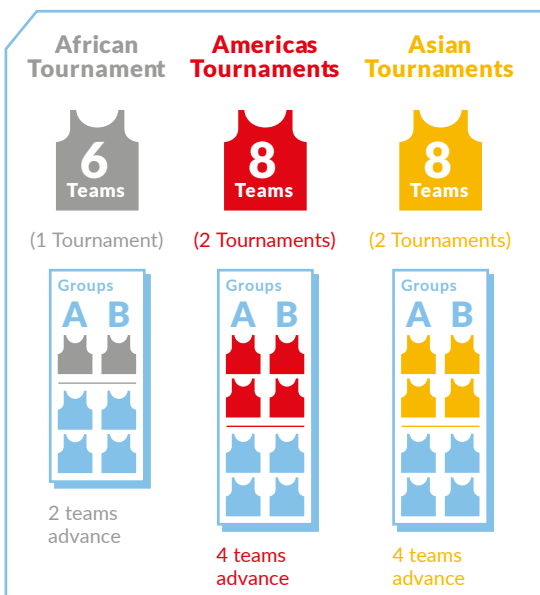
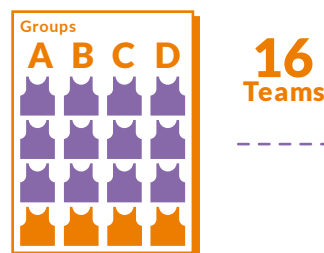


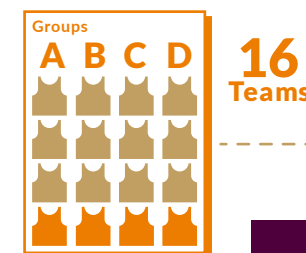

The top 6 teams from FIBA Women's EuroBasket will qualify directly to FIBA Women's Olympic Qualifying Tournaments 2020.

\* Despite having already qualified for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, the FIBA Women's Basketball World Cup 2018 Champions USA and Japan – as the Host Country of the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games will play the FIBA Women's Olympic Qualifying Tournaments and advance regardless of their results. Consequently, only the two best placed teams from the respective tournaments will qualify.

Consequently, only the two best placed teams from the respective tournaments will qualify.
