## **QUALIFIERS** A total of ten (10) groups play in Round Robin system home & away. ## TEAMS QUALIFIED FOR THE FIBA WOMEN'S EUROBASKET 2023

Ten (10) group winners and the four (4) best second placed teams will qualify for the Final Round of the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2023 to fill the remaining fourteen (14) spots.



## **FIBA WOMEN'S EUROBASKET 2023**

Note: From groups F & I, only the group winners will qualify directly to the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2023. The 2nd placed teams from these two groups (F & I) do not qualify and also are not compared with the other second-placed teams from the other groups. The four (4) best second-placed teams out of the eight (8) remaining groups qualify to the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2023. To determine the standings within a group, all games will be taken into account. To determine the four (4) best second-placed teams out of the eight (8) applicable groups, the results against 4th placed teams in the groups of four teams will be disregarded to compare the teams on a like-for-like basis as per the Official Basketball Rules.

In case one of the hosts of the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2023 is among the 14 spots that qualify to the event (10 group winners and 4 best 2nd placed teams), the 5th best 2nd placed team will also qualify to the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2023. In case of both hosts being among the 14 spots that qualify, then also the 6th best 2nd placed advances to the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2023.
